



RENK AG invests in Augsburg Headquarters

RENK AG, based in Augsburg, has embarked on the implementation of a large-scale investment package. This package amounts to several tens of millions of euros in total and will be used to boost production capacities at the Augsburg location. These significant investments are driven by the company's positive outlook for its Augsburg-based business areas, which it will no longer be able to accommodate with its current mechanical fabrication, assembly, and test rig capacities. As the company is unable to meet these increased capacity requirements due to a lack of available space, the decision was made to expand the assembly area by constructing a new building.

RENK AG is also making its test rigs more modern and flexible in order to boost its capacities. The firm is working on this together with RENK Test System GmbH, the company's test rig specialists, who are also based at the same location in Augsburg.

The current lack of space is essentially affecting the entire factory premises. For this reason, the company has decided to make its new building a two-story assembly hall in order to improve the use of space. In addition to the two floors design, RENK AG is also taking an innovative and contemporary approach regarding the construction of this new factory building. The design for the front of the administrative building integrates smoothly into the streetscape

and encloses over 4,000 m² of production area on each floor of the building behind it. In addition to appearance, RENK AG is also focusing on technology and sustainability in its construction project. As a result, the new factory area including the office building will be both heated and cooled almost entirely by an environmentally friendly brine/water heat pump system. This will allow the company to eliminate the use of fossil fuels to the greatest extent possible. Moreover, the design of the building's roof – which features extensive green space – also makes a positive contribution to the new building's environmental footprint, in addition to its renewable heating and cooling technology.

These investments are targeted steps to implement the overall growth strategy of RENK AG in Augsburg. This move also reflects a positive outlook and a commitment to jobs in Augsburg.
